

The candidate should be an Indian National .Passed minimum Three-year Duration Bachelor's Degree awarded by any of the Universities recognized by University Grants Commission or Association of Indian Universities in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent (at least 45% in case of candidates of backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) or its equivalent.

2. *Master of Computer Applications (MCA):* Two years program with intake of 60 Students per year

Eligibility Criteria for Appearing to Online MAH-MCA-CET 2020

- (i) The candidate should be an Indian National;
- (ii) Passed minimum three year duration Bachelor's Degree awarded by University recognized by University Grants Commission or Association of Indian Universities in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent (at least 45% in case of candidates of backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only);
- (iii) Studied Mathematics as one of the subjects at (10+2) level or at Graduate level examination.

Selection Process

Admission to the MMS, MCA program is done under Merit Seats. Admission under this quota is made by the State CET Cell through their Centralized Admission Process (CAP). Applicants are advised to refer to the CET Booklet for further details.

Infrastructure

PLACEMENT GUIDELINES



- > It is the prime responsibility of students to check all the updates related to campus recruitment drives, its eligibility, dates, venue etc. available on your registered email accounts.
- > It is mandatory for all eligible students to appear in all companies coming for campus placement till they get placed. Failing to do so may result in cancellation of their candidature for further campus recruitments drives and no assistance will be extended to such students under any circumstances.
- > Students will be given a choice to back out after the presentation (PPT) of the company. No student will be allowed to back out from the company after clearing the 1st round, and also after getting selected. Failing which the student shall be barred from the entire placement.
- All students need to ensure that they meet the eligibility criteria of the company as mentioned in the email. All mark sheets are checked at the time of joining and if company finds that you have man ipulated your marks/documents at the time of campus recruitment your job offer will be terminated and your name will be blacklisted forever.
- All students need to ensure that their data is correctly given at placement office. If there are any changes then they need to contact the placement officer immediately.

- > Students have to ensure that they report on time as mentioned in the email. Students coming late will be strictly not allowed to appear in that process.
- > Students have to wear business formals for every recruitment process. Students wearing casuals during recruitment process will be sent back.
- Students are not allowed to contact company/hr delegates directly for any reason. If they are facing any problem they have to first contact their placement officer and discuss their problem with them.
- > Students have to arrange their own transport during campus/off campus recruitments.
- > The institute strictly follows "one student one job policy".
- Many a times it can happen that campus recruitment process can stretch late in the evening. All students have to inform this to their parents and should arrange their own transportation.
- > Strict discipline needs to be followed by every student during the recruitment process. Any students found misbehaving or doing any sort of misconduct will be debarred from the entire placementseason.
- > Students are expected to research relevant website and make themselves acquainted with the locations, services offered, products in the market, HR policies and all other relevant information about the organization.


